The State of Connecticut tax credit program provides for a 30% return on expenses associated with rehabilitating owner-occupied one- to four-family homes listed on the State or National Register of Historic Places, which includes homes in the Farmington and Unionville Historic Districts. This workshop will detail the program's benefits, qualifying work, and the application process.
