### TIREBITER BAND

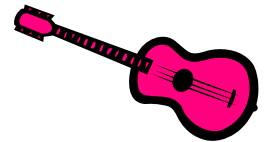
**Thursday, July 1 from 7:00 - 8:30 p.m.**
