Special Meeting Minutes

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at approximately 4:52 p.m.
- II. **Roll Call:** Members present in person: Chris Mathieu, Matthew Hutvagner Mark Simson and Ronald White. (All arrived between 4:45-5:00 p.m.)

- III. **New Business:** The Board heard appeals from the following persons claiming to be aggrieved by the doings of the Assessor.
 - Waleed Alamoudi, 2006 Toyota Sienna. Members, Mathieu, Hutvagner and Simpson viewed the vehicle.
 - Waleed Alamoudi, 2014 Toyota Camry. The vehicle was not brought to the hearing.
 - Philip Smith, 1995 Porsche Carrera. Members present in person viewed the vehicle.
 - Robert Wheeler, 2009 Freightliner (with Forest River Berkshire body) motor home. Members present in person viewed the vehicle.
 - Jay Zaleski from Ales Renovations LLC, 2002 Chevrolet Silverado. The vehicle was not brought to the hearing.
 - Philip Mays, 1968 Ford Mustang. The vehicle was not brought to the hearing.
 - Susann McCarthy, 2008 Ford Focus: Had requested an appointment, but did not appear.
- IV. **Deliberation and Voting:** The members gathered near the telephone to deliberate.
 - Waleed Alamoudi, 2006 Toyota Sienna. Ron White made, and Chris Mathieu seconded a motion to reduce the retail value from \$5,350 to \$4,650 for high mileage. The motion passed unanimously.
 - Waleed Alamoudi, 2014 Toyota Camry. Chris Mathieu made, and Mark Simpson seconded a motion to deny the appeal. The motion passed unanimously.
 - Philip Smith, 1995 Porsche Carrera. Chris Mathieu made, and Ronald White seconded a motion to deny Appeal. The motion passed unanimously.
 - Jay Zaleski from Ales Renovations LLC, 2002 Chevrolet Silverado. Ron White made, and Chris Mathieu seconded a motion to reduce the retail value from \$3,500 to \$1,800. The motion passed unanimously.
 - Philip Mays, 1968 Ford Mustang. Chris Mathieu made, and Ron White seconded a motion to reduce the assessment to \$500. The motion passed unanimously.
 - Robert Wheeler, 2009 Freightliner (with Forest River Berkshire body) motor home. Chris Mathieu made, and Ron White seconded a motion to reduce the retail value from \$99,900 to \$75,000. The motion passed unanimously.
