Route 4 CRCOG Corridor Study	CRCOG	The Town of Farmington in conjunction with CRCOG, received approval for a corridor study for Route 4 from I-84 ramp to the West Hartford Town line to address transportation needs and deficiencies in the areas surrounding UConn Health Center and the Greater Hartford University of Connecticut (UConn) campus. The study area includes Route 4 and the roadways surrounding UConn Health Farmington in the eastern portion of Farmington including Interstate Ramps, State Highways and local roads. The study will take a year to a year and half to complete.	Study Complete- will be presented to the Town Council at an upcoming meeting for approval
South Road-Two Mile- Colt Highway Roundabout	CRCOG	The Town of Farmington partnered with Metro Realty to design a roundabout for the intersection of South Road, Two Mile Road, and Colt Highway to improve traffic flow through the intersection with the traffic increases from developments.	Preliminary Plans have been sent to DOT for review
Brickyard Road Milling and Paving- Phase 2	CRCOG	Phase 2 will include milling, pavement overlay, and Select Drainage Replacement from Wildwood Road to the Avon Town Line. This project is to be funded through the LOTCIP program through Conn DOT and CRCOG.	Estimated Start of Construction Summer 2021
